Preparatory Programme for International Students



About the Foundation Course

The Foundation Course is an English-taught programme designed to prepare international students for entry into Italian universities, particularly those who hold a **high school diploma** but do not yet meet the formal requirements for direct admission, as well as those wishing to strengthen their academic and language skills before beginning undergraduate studies.

Is this course right for me?

- YES** if you plan to study in Italy but do not yet meet the formal entry requirements for Italian universities
- YES** if you have completed high school with fewer than 12 years of schooling and hold a full high school diploma, leaving certificate, or equivalent qualification
- YES** if you would like to improve your academic English or Italian before starting an undergraduate degree at an Italian university
- YES** if you have a required level of English

Language Modules (First semester, online)

Following a placement test, students are grouped based on their proficiency in Italian and English, allowing for a personalised learning pathway and a more effective learning experience.
